

Terms and conditions

- 1.** The Organiser and Data Controller of the National Pubwatch Awards is National Pubwatch, PO Box 76958, London, N21 9FJ.
- 2.** By submitting the application for the National Pubwatch Awards the entrant will be deemed to have read and understood these rules and be bound by them. These rules include any instructions set out in the entry form.
- 3.** Entries must be submitted and be received by the time and date stated on entry form.
- 4.** Entries will only be accepted if they are submitted on the entry form which has been completed in full.
- 5.** The entrant will take responsibility for responding to all correspondence with National Pubwatch relating to this application.
- 6.** Responsibility cannot be taken for any late, lost or mislaid entry and any entry which does not comply with these terms and conditions may be deemed invalid at the sole discretion of the Organiser.
- 7.** The judges may decline to make awards if, in their opinion there are insufficient entries of a winning standard.
- 8.** There will be a maximum of 3 nominated finalists with one scheme being judged as overall winner, selected against the criteria set out in the entry form by a panel of judges appointed by the Organiser.
- 9.** The Organiser reserves the right at its absolute discretion to reject any entry it deems inappropriate.
- 10.** The winner will be announced at the parliamentary reception.
- 11.** Only the finalists will be contacted personally.
- 12.** The Organiser reserves the right to change the judging panel without prior notice to entrants.
- 13.** The judges' decision on all matters concerning the Awards is final and legally binding. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 14.** Finalists may be required to take part in some post-event publicity and consent to their name and photograph being used for such purposes.
- 15.** Entrant's consent to the publication by the Organiser in connection with the Awards any of the documents or materials constituting their entry.
- 16.** Any winner may publicise its Award provided the year in which it was won is stated.
- 17.** By entering the Awards, all entrants will be deemed to have accepted and be bound by the rules and consent to the transfer of their data to the Data Controller for the purposes of the administration of the Awards and any other purposes to which the entrant has consented.
- 18.** By entering the awards the entrant agrees that members of the scheme will be available to attend and fully participate in the parliamentary award ceremony.
- 19.** The Organiser will not be liable for any travel or accommodation costs in relation to attendance of the award ceremony.
- 20.** The organiser has sole discretion as to how many places will be available to finalists at the awards ceremony.
- 21.** All documentation containing personal information about individuals who have been subject to banning or appeal must be redacted. NPW will not accept responsibility for circulation by applicants of any documentation that breaches data protection law.
